What I have to do when I'm in DÜSSELDORF:

1. register at the municipal reception centre at Vogelsanger Weg 49:

Opening hours: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday 9-12:00.

The municipal reception centre helps with applications for financial assistance (asylum seeker benefits or citizen's allowance).

2. go to the Gesundheitsamt:

Kölner Str. 180, 40227 Düsseldorf

Monday to Friday 8-12:00, Monday to

Thursday 13-15:30. You will undergo a

medical examination. You will then receive a

health certificate and an allocation to

municipal accommodation.

3. see which accommodation it is:

The accommodation you have been allocated is on a city list sorted by district. Click on the city districts and compare them with your allocated address.



4. register with the city at the Bürgerbüro, Willi-Becker-Allee 7, 40227 Düsseldorf

You will travel to the allocated accommodation with the allocation letter. With the allocation you register at the Bürgerbüro. The Citizens' Office is located on the ground floor: it is best to come in the morning. There you will receive a confirmation of registration(see sample).
